 - Burning of magnesium ribbon in air
 - Zinc with dilute sulphuric acid
 - Heating of copper sulphate crystals
 - Sodium sulphate with barium chloride in the form of their solutions in water

5. Verification of law of conservation of mass in a chemical reaction.
